OUTBOARD MOTOR MOUNTING on BOATS

It has come to our attention that some dealers are installing large horsepower Mercury Outboards on boats and using only two of the specified four (4) clamp bracket mounting bolts.

There is a warning tag attached to each Mercury Outboard, as shown in illustrations below. Read them carefully and adhere to the requirements. Mounting stipulations also are outlined under "Motor Installation" in "Operation and Maintenance Manuals" and in the "Outboard Service Manual".



The statement, "DEALER DO NOT REMOVE THIS TAG", is distinct at the top on both sides of the tag, and it should not be removed by anyone but the retail purchaser. It is a warning for both you (the dealer) and the customer to be sure that the motor is bolted properly on the transom.

Also, it is important that the customer should. ... "See additional instructions in your 'Operation and Maintenance Manual' which accompanies your Mercury Outboard Motor". This will alert to the various "Warnings" and "Cautions" and instructions in the manual.
