A. BLEED CHECK VALVE ASSEMBLY – 3 CYLINDER MODELS 70–75–80–90 AND 4 CYLINDER MODEL 100

There have been reports of the nylon ball burning out of crankcase bleed check valves (P/N 21 –42657A1) on the above listed outboards. When this occurs, the outboard idles poorly and fouls spark plugs at low RPM. Should it be determined that the bleed check valve is at fault, replace the check valves with Bleed Check Valve Restrictor Kit P/N 22–814204A1. (Figure 1) When installed according to instructions the restrictor will prevent the check valve nylon ball from burning out.

Future production outboards, starting with Serial Number 0C123214, of the above models will have the restrictor installed.
