Obstructed Fuel Line Connector – Mariner/Mercury 8-200 Models

Fuel line connector P/N 22-13563A3 may have excess plastic in the fuel passageway inside the housing. Excess plastic may prevent full coupling of the fuel line to the outboard furl connector and/or restrict fuel flow to the engine. Outboards and service stock listed require inspection of fuel line connector.

INSPECTION:

Inspect for excess plastic in passageway by looking into connector from fuel line barbed end. Brass piece on opposite end of connector should be fully visible. If brass piece is not visible, the connector is defective and must be replaced.
