135/150 Optimax Update

Models Affected

MERCURY/MARINER S/N 0G636539 Thru S/N 0G760299

Listed are items to be updated on early production 135/150 HP, Optimax/DFI outboards. Improvements are being offered to current owners and are to be made on outboards in dealer inventory to provide improved reliability, durability and performance. The updated items listed have been implemented on production outboards as running changes.

Owner Notification – USA/Canada

A letter will be sent to every registered owner of an affected outboard. The letter will advise the owner to return their outboard to their selling dealer or any Mercury/Mariner authorized dealer for the updates, listed on this bulletin and previous Service Bulletin 98-3. Some engines may have already had the updates listed on Service Bulletin 98-3 performed. Please refer to Bulletin 98-3 for indentification of these updates, or check engine history using the Midas system. A copy of the letter is included with this Service Bulletin. Note: Customer letters were not sent as mentioned on Service Bulletin 98-3 due to parts shortages. Sufficient parts are now in stock to complete both updates.

Dealer Outboard Inventory

Affected outboards in dealer inventory MUST BE updated prior to customer delivery.

ITEM # 1 FLYWHEEL COVER - S/N 0G636539 THRU S/N 0G654821

Replace flywheel cover with new flywheel cover **P/N 827325A7** with improved fuel hose retainer.



ITEM # 2 FUEL HOSE & PUMP UPGRADE – S/N 0G636539 THRU S/N 0G742514

Several fuel hose and pump changes have been made to improve fuel hose clearance, routing, and pump durability. Install upgrade kit **P/N 803025A1**, all parts and instruction sheet are included in kit.

NOTE: To crimp metal fuel system clamps, use Mercury special tool **P/N 91-803146T**, Snap-On tool **P/N YA3080**, or equivalent.

ITEM # 3 BELT TENSIONER ARM - S/N 0G636539 THRU S/N 0G760299

Install new tensioner arm that has improved center support bushing and additional grease fitting. Order arm kit **P/N 856815A3** which includes tensioner arm, center support bushing, mounting stud, and installation instructions.

ITEM # 4 ALTERNATOR BRACKET - S/N 0G636539 THRU S/N 0G760299

Install new rubber mounted brackets that will help isolate the alternator from vibration.

Bracket kit **P/N 856974A1** includes brackets, rubber mounts, mounting hardware, and installation instructions.

ITEM # 5 LOOSE BATTERY CABLES – S/N 0G636539 THRU 0G760299

Loose battery cables, can cause false fail codes and running problems. Check for loose or corroded connections. There have been reports of the negative cable retainer bolt bottoming out in the threaded hole before sufficient battery cable clamp load is obtained. If battery cable can be rotated by hand, install flat stainless steel washer **P/N 12-814806** between battery cable and lower starter motor end cap.
