VesselView Restarts During Normal Operation of Diesel Axius Models

Models Affected

Situation

Cummins MerCruiser Diesel has received reports that some Axius-equipped vessels with either the QSD 2.8L or QSD 4.2L engines have experienced VesselView restarts during normal vessel operation. These restarts may occur randomly and cause momentary loss of gauge information on the VesselView display.

Perform the procedures described in the following CMD service bulletins during the same service visit if they have not already been completed:

Correction

Update VesselView software to version 3.15.0.86.

Cummins MerCruiser Diesel has released a new version of VesselView software (Ver. 3.15.0.86) that addresses random VesselView restarts. Updating the VesselView software to version 3.15.0.86 will correct the issue.

This document provides instructions for updating the VesselView and VesselConfig software.

IMPORTANT: Perform the software update on each VesselView installed.

Obtaining the Update Files

IMPORTANT: The SmartCraft Download Center requires access permission and a login. Most Cummins MerCruiser Diesel authorized distributors and service centers already have access to the SmartCraft Download Center. If you do not, contact Cummins MerCruiser Diesel to request access.

The VesselView update files are available at the SmartCraft Download Center.

- 1. Access the SmartCraft Download Center by visiting www.cmdmarine.com.
- 2. Select the SmartCraft hyperlink from the top menu.
- 3. Select the **Download Center** hyperlink from the left-hand menu.
- 4. Select the **Technician Site** hyperlink.
- 5. Use your user id and password to login to the Cummins site.
- 6. Select the VesselView Update hyperlink to access the update files.
- 7. Select the VV 86 Update.exe file. This compressed self-extracting file contains two VesselView programming files.

IMPORTANT: VesselView will not recognize files that are not in the root directory of the USB drive.

8. Use a PC to extract the update files and copy them to the root directory (not in a folder) of a USB drive.

Export the Current VesselView Settings

IMPORTANT:

When updating VesselView software from a version older than 3.xx.x.xx, the software configuration file exported will not be importable from within the version 3.15.0.86 software. In this case, you must record all VesselView configuration settings before the software upgrade and manually enter the settings after the software upgrade.

1. Press the menu button until the VesselView main menu appears. Then navigate to the "Calibrate" menu and select "Save Configs" using the directional keypad.



2. Press the enter (check mark) button. The following screen will appear asking you to insert the USB memory stick. Insert the USB drive into the USB port on the rear of the VesselView unit or into the USB extension harness (if installed).

- 6. Remove the USB drive.

Perform Factory Reset

IMPORTANT: This procedure can be performed in any VesselView or VesselConfig screen.

- 1. Ensure that both key switches are in the ON position.
- 2. Insert the USB drive with the required **FactoryReset.RI2** file into the USB port on the rear of the VesselView unit or into the USB extension harness (if installed).

NOTE: The "New Upgrades Available" window will appear once the VesselView has scanned the USB drive for the appropriate files. Once found, you will receive a prompt to select the update files.

VesselView and VesselConfig Upgrades

IMPORTANT: This procedure can be performed in any VesselView or VesselConfig screen.

1. Insert the USB drive with the required **FactoryReset.RI2** file into the USB port on the rear of the VesselView unit or into the USB extension harness (if installed).

NOTE: The "New Upgrades Available" window will appear after the VesselView has scanned the USB drive for the appropriate files. You will then receive a prompt to select the update files.

NOTE: If the "New Upgrades Available" screen times-out before you select the update file, remove then reinsert the USB drive and the screen will reappear.

Loading VesselView Configuration Data

IMPORTANT: Perform the software update on each VesselView unit installed. After the update is complete, VesselView will reboot and display the following first-time startup screen.



1. Press the trackpad right arrow to proceed to the VesselView setup procedure.



2. Insert the USB drive with the exported vessel view configuration file into the USB port on the rear of the VesselView unit or into the USB extension harness (if installed).

- 6. Using the trackpad up and down arrows, highlight "Calibrate" and press the enter (check mark) button.
- 7. In the "Calibrate" screen, use the trackpad up and down arrows to highlight "Configuration" then press the enter (check mark) button to select "Configuration."
- Set the "HELM ID", "DEVICE ID", "NUM ENGINES", "RIGHT SCREEN", and "LEFT SCREEN" to the appropriate values for the vessel application by using the trackpad arrows then press the enter (check mark) button to save the settings.
 IMPORTANT: When the VesselView main screen is displayed the update is complete.
