## Removing a GPS Unit from Its Pedestal

### Scope

Worldwide.

### Models Affected

All Axis Premier packages.

### Situation

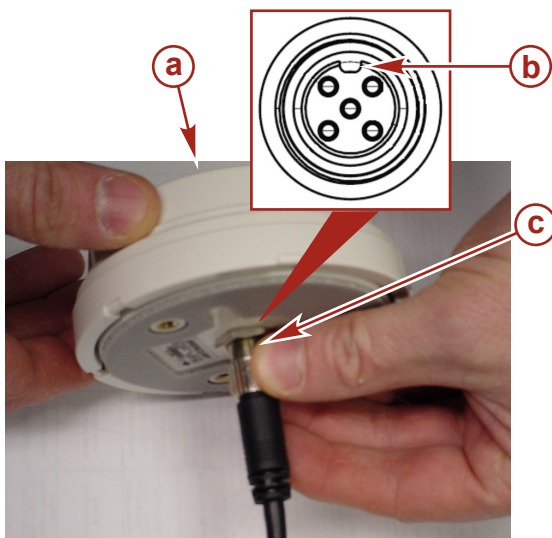
Removing a GPS unit from the pedestal requires special care to prevent twisting of the CAN H NMEA 2K harness.

1. Remove the three screws from the base of the GPS unit.  
**IMPORTANT: Do not twist the base of the GPS from the pedestal.**
2. Gently pull the GPS unit up from the base and support the GPS unit while turning the CAN H NMEA 2K harness connector counterclockwise.
3. Loosen and remove the CAN H NMEA 2K harness .  
**IMPORTANT: The threaded connector must be completely loose before removal to avoid damage to the cable or GPS unit.**

### Installation

When installing, make sure the CAN H NMEA 2K harness does not twist in the supporting tube. If the base was removed, install the base to the standard marine mount pole before attaching the CAN H NMEA 2K cable and base to the GPS.

1. Support the GPS unit while connecting the cable.
2. Align the keyway of the CAN H NMEA 2K harness connector to the GPS unit connector and tighten securely.

3. Make sure the base is secured to the pedestal.

4. Place the GPS unit on the base and install the 3 screws. Tighten.
