Since it is impossible to plate individual cylinders, the block is stripped and all cylinders are re-plated. If the cylinder block requires new replacement sleeves, there will be an additional sleeve installation charge. Please call or fax U.S. Chrome Corp. for current plating and sleeve installation charges.

Before shipping a block to U.S. Chrome for re-plating, remove the following:

- All studs and dowel pins
- Locating pins (except center main bearings)
- All gasket material
- · Carbon build up in the exhaust chest
