

## Warranty and Registration of Unsold Non-Current Inflatable Boats

### Non-Current Inflatable Boats

Proper inspection is required to ensure the boat is in good working order and is in warrantable condition to ensure customer satisfaction.

#### Category #1 - One or Two Model Years Non-Current

1. Inspect for damage or staining that may have occurred during shipping, storage or display.
2. Inspect to ensure that all accessories that accompany the normal boat package are included.
3. Complete and submit the warranty registration per normal instructions.

#### Category #2 - Three to Five Model Years Non-Current

1. Complete inspection steps 1 and 2 from Category #1.
2. Inflate the boat to ensure there are no air leaks in flotation chambers, keel, air deck, or valves. It is recommended that the boat remain inflated for 24 hours to ensure air-holding integrity.
3. Complete and submit the warranty registration per current instructions.

#### Category #3 - Six or More Model Years Non-Current

Inflatables that are 6 or more years non-current are not eligible for factory warranty. Complete inspections from Categories #1 and #2 to ensure customer satisfaction. **The Bill of Sale should be marked "Sold Without Factory Warranty".**

### Warranty

Parts and labor required to prepare Category #2 boats for sale are not covered under warranty. Shipping, storage or display damage, or staining on Category #2 boats is not covered under warranty.



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
