The oil thermostat assembly is wearing out due to the high oil pressure that the piston is exposed to during normal operation.

Correction

The thermostat and piston have to be replaced as a maintenance item every 50 hours of engine running time.

Assembly

Parts Required

Qty.	Description	Part Number
1	Thermostat	816163 1
1	Piston	849983

1. Assemble the piston to the temperature bulb as shown with the spring cup of the piston facing the spring.
