





Steering Attachment Bolt 10-849838

Models Affected

All Mercury and Mariner <u>Hi-Performance Outboards</u>: Pro Max/Super Magnum 150/200/225/& 300 All 2.5 EFI Models

Beginning on January 2, 1998 all Hi-Performance model outboards have been shipped with a new steering attachment bolt, 10-849838, which attaches the steering link rod to the steering tiller arm.

When servicing steering components on Hi-Performance outboards built before January of 1998, the steering attachment bolt should be replaced with the new bolt.

BOLT IDENTIFICATION



- a Recommended Bolt (10-849838) for All Hi-Performance Engines Has Vendor Letters (ARP) on Head
- **b** Bolt Used Before January, 1998 Has No Letters.

STEERING ATTACHMENT COMPONENTS USED ON HI-PERFORMANCE OUT-BOARDS SHOULD BE VISUALLY INSPECTED FOR WEAR, LUBRICATED AND ALL ATTACHMENT HARDWARE CHECKED FOR PROPER TORQUE TIGHTNESS EVERY 25 HRS. OF OPERATION.

- 1. An access hole is provided thru the bottom cowl to ease installation of the link rod connecting bolt. Reinstall plug after completion.
- 2. Install steering link rod per illustration.



- a Special Bolt (10-849838) Tighten to 20 lb. ft. (27 N·m)
- b- Nylon Insert Locknut (11-34863) -Tighten Until Nut Seats Then Back Off 1/4 Turn
- c Nylon Insert Locknut Tighten to 20 lb. ft. (27 N m) after Torquing (a)
- d Flat Washers
- e 30W Motor Oil
- f Lubricate with 2-4-C With Teflon (92-825407A12) or Special Lubricant 101 (92-13872A1)
